## Campaign Overview

Connected by COAST is a campaign to raise \$7 million to support the future of public transportation and the economic, social, and environmental benefits it generates. The campaign celebrates COAST's 40+ years of connecting people and communities in the Greater Seacoast region of New Hampshire and southern Maine, and will lay the foundation for the next 40+ years.

The campaign has three funding areas, including advancing a state-of-the-art facility, which offers naming opportunities for donors of \$15,000 or more.

An investment in COAST's new facility is a down payment on the future and has the potential to be transformational for public transit in the region. The new facility will allow COAST to help further drive and support the economic growth of the Seacoast.

## Advancing a State-of-the-Art Facility



In the last 15 years in particular, COAST has experienced its most significant growth. In order to better meet its current operational needs, be responsive to future demand and reduce its environmental impact, COAST plans to build a new 48,000 square foot facility on its current property in Dover.

All gifts to the Connected By COAST Campaign will be recognized immediately unless the donor requests anonymity. Recognition may take the form of articles and listings in the COAST's annual impact report, announcements on the organization's website, press releases or acknowledgement at special campaign events.
