In honor of all who have served our country, on Veterans Day (observed Monday, November 12, 2018), all United States military personnel who are currently active, or who have previously served, will be able to board any COAST bus or service for free.

Upon boarding on Veterans Day, US military personnel can present a retiree or active duty military ID, a NH license with veteran status displayed, a DD-214 (discharge papers), or a VA card as evidence of their service. Spouses and dependents boarding with military personnel will also be allowed to ride for free.
