How do I schedule a ride?

- To schedule rides, simply contact COAST's call center, TripLink, at 603-834-6010 triplink@communityrides.org.
- You will be asked to provide some basic information including your name, phone number, and where you want to be picked up and dropped off.
- Reservation requests must be made by 4:00pm the weekday before the day you wish to ride (by Friday at 4:00pm for Monday trips).
- You may set up standing orders for trips you take routinely (e.g. work or physical therapy).
- Actual pick up and drop off times may vary by up to an hour from the requested time to accommodate grouping customers on trips. Actual times will be communicated to you in advance.
- COAST will ensure that customers who need to be at an appointment by a specific time will have that time honored.

What is Route 7 On Demand?

Route 7 On Demand is an advance-reservation-only shared-ride service.

This means, if you wish to travel in the Route 7 Service Area, you must call in advance to schedule your trips, and you will likely be traveling with other passengers.

The type of vehicle we send to pick you up will vary based on demand for that day.



Who can use the service?

This service is open to the public. No advanced application or eligibility process is required!

When does the service operate?

The service is available on Mondays, Wednesdays, Thursdays, and Saturdays from 9:30am to 5:15pm.

Designated Stops

There are several Designated Stops in Newmarket and Exeter, and one Designated Stop in Stratham.

If you request to be picked up **and** dropped off at designated stops, your fare will be \$1.50 each time you board.

Traveling to Other Locations in the Service Area (Non-Designated Stops)


You can also request to be picked up and/or dropped off at any location within the Route 7 Service Area (¾ of a mile from the Designated Stops).

If you request a pick-up **and/or** drop-off at a Non-Designated Stop within the Service Area, your fare will be \$3.00 each time you board.
